# STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Parochial Church Council (PCC) is a corporate body established by the Church of England and operates under the Parochial Church Councils (Powers) Measure 1956.

St Andrew's is in the United Benefice of St Andrew, Cobham and St Mary, Stoke D'Abernon. The United Benefice shares a ministry team but each parish has its own PCC and church officers. This arrangement became subject to a Pastoral Reorganisation during the second half of 2018. In February 2019 the United benefice ended whereby St Andrew and St Mary became separate single benefices.

The appointment of PCC members is governed by and set out in the Church Representation Rules.

# **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

The primary objective of the PCC is the promotion of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to the doctrines and practices of the Church of England.

The PCC is responsible for co-operating with the incumbent in promoting in the ecclesiastical parish the whole mission of the Church, pastoral, evangelistic, social and ecumenical.

The PCC has agreed a vision statement as follows: To Know, Glorify and Make Christ Known

St Andrews continues to seek to be a Christian community through which all can come to know and accept God's love for them and reflect that love wherever they are.

#### **ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE**

In September 2018 Revd Dr Michael Branscombe was licensed as Priest-in-Charge of the United Benefice during a time of pastoral reorganisation. His initial months were spent in learning about the parish and managing changes brought about by the resignation of the Churchwardens in September. During a long vacancy many people take on new responsibilities and our new priest is keen to thank those who have done so much, our non-stipendiary minister, Revd Charleen Hollington, Retired Priest, Revd Peter Vickers, training Ordinand, Moni Babatunde and Children & Youth minister, Esther Holley and Elaine Bray, Communications & Administration Manager handling the increased workload in our busy Parish Office.

David Taylor and Cathy Whitnall have also helped with occasional preaching. Kevin Ayton has continued to act as Director of Music pending a permanent appointment Which was made in March 2019

# St Andrew's Parochial Church Council, Cobham

We still continue to develop the five-year vision for the parish, Vision 2018. Church attendance is a little decreased, but this is not uncommon when there is a vacancy. Our vision priorities continued to be focused on Worship, Children Family & Youth, Generosity, Financial Management and Faith and Social Action. Progress continued to be made in the Children and Youth ministry as Esther Holley grows her mission at St Andrew's both with the church family as well as in the community through her work with Elmbridge Family Services in Cobham.

We consider our Children and Youth Ministry is key to the present and future of our church. We also continued to sustain other strong links with the local community, in particular with our support for St Andrew's School, Messy Church, Oasis Family Centre, Cobham Area Foodbank and Heritage Day.

In order to fill the post of Rector for the United Benefice was advertised for a second time in January 2018 and in March 3 candidates were invited and visited the parish to meet members of the congregation and for interviews the next day. One candidate was offered the role but subsequently declined it. The other two candidates were not offered the role. The Bishop of Dorking then introduced Revd Dr Mike Branscombe to the Churchwardens who the invited him and his family to visit the parish and be interviewed in June 2018. Following the visit and interview Mike was appointed Priest-in-Charge.

# **FINANCIAL REVIEW**

The accounts exclude the balances of the G Sanders fund which is explained in note 2 of the accounts.

Total unrestricted income was £192,811, after deducting expenditure of £190,885 a surplus of £1,926 resulted. This surplus was partly caused by unrestricted legacy of £10,000 from Ray Sherlock without which the deficiency before the revaluation of investments on unrestricted funds would be £8,074.

Unrealised loss of £8,577 on investments in the unrestricted fund resulted in a balance of unrestricted reserves carried forward of £738,354.

The restricted reserves decreased from £29,954 to £17,595, a decrease of £12,359. Most of this was due to restricted income of £1,575 being exceeded by restricted expenditure of £14,034 leading a deficit in the year of £12,359. The restricted reserves carried forward are £17,595.

#### **RESERVES POLICY**

The PCC has agreed to maintain sufficient reserves of not less than six months average expenditure to cover emergency situations that may arise from time to time. Our reserves are more than adequate to meet this criteria.

# NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS For the year ended 31st December 2018

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 together with applicable accounting standards and the Charities (the application of FRS 102).

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention except for the valuation of investment assets, which are shown at market value.

The financial statements include all transactions, assets and liabilities for which the PCC is responsible in law. They do not include the accounts of church groups that owe their main affiliation to another body, nor to those that are informal gatherings of church members.

#### **Funds**

Unrestricted funds are general funds which can be used for PCC ordinary purposes.

Restricted funds represent donations or grants received for a specific object or invited by the PCC for a specific object. The funds may only be expended on the specific object for which they were given. Any balance remaining unspent at the end of each year must be carried forward as a balance on that fund.

# **Incoming resources**

Planned giving, collections and donations are recognised when received. Tax refunds are recognised when the income to which they relate is received. Grants and legacies are accounted for when received or when the PCC is legally entitled to the amounts due. Dividends are accounted for when receivable, interest is accrued. All other income is recognised when it is receivable.

All incoming resources are accounted for gross.

Unrealised gains or losses on investments are accounted for on revaluation of investments at 31st December.

#### Resources used

Grants and donations are accounted for when paid over, or when awarded, if that award creates a binding obligation on the PCC. The diocesan parish share is accounted for when due. All other expenditure is generally recognised when it is incurred and is accounted for gross.

#### Fixed assets

Benefice and consecrated property is not included in the accounts in accordance with s.10(2)(a) and (c) of the Charities Act 2011.

No value is attributable to movable church furnishings held by the churchwardens on special trust for the PCC, and which require a faculty for disposal, since the PCC considers these to be inalienable property.

Any expenditure during the year on consecrated or benefice property and movable church furnishings, whether maintenance or improvement, has been written off.

Church Gate House Centre, including the flat and the land on which it stands are valued at cost. No depreciation is charged on these properties but expenditure on maintenance or improvement is written off as incurred. These buildings are subject to an annual impairment review.

Equipment acquired for Church Gate House Centre has been depreciated, on a straight line, basis over 10 years. The piano, the computer and the projector have been fully depreciated. Individual items of equipment costing under £1000 are written off when the asset is acquired.

Investments are valued at market value at 31st December.

# **Current Assets**

Amounts owing to the PCC at 31st December in respect of tax, rent or other income are shown as debtors.

#### 2 DECONSOLIDATION OF THE G SANDERS FUND

The G Sanders fund was a gift to the church wardens which originated in 1956 and in broad terms is an endowment for the benefit of the clergy of St Andrew's Church Cobham and their families. In 2012 the fund was included in the PCC accounts as a restricted fund.

This treatment has been reconsidered in conjunction with a Custodian Trust Administrator at the Diocese, and it was decided that that the figures should not be in our accounts and the assets etc. should be in the custody of the Diocesan Board of Finance.

The account balances which have been excluded from these accounts due to the deconsolidation of the G Sanders trust are as follows.

# Independent Examiner's Report To the Parochial Church Council (PCC) of St Andrew's Cobham

I report on the accounts for the year ended 31 December 2018, which are set out on pages 1 to 14.

# Respective responsibilities of the Trustees and Independent Examiner

The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed. It is my responsibility to
